

In the end we trust that Powys Council will 'do the right thing' and finance the school - that's what we've paid our taxes for!

The Welsh Government made £1.4bn available last year for new school building. PCC admit they declined to bid for a share for Hay - they already had the supermarket plan lined up. This should never have happened in the first place, the council should have applied for money for a new school for the town.

In the meantime, our Fundraising team is looking at alternatives; other developments that could raise the finance, direct funding from the Welsh Government, private donations and money raised from other redundant PCC land and buildings. This work is looking promising.
